Terms to Know

Copay

The set fee you pay each time you use a medical service covered by your plan.

Deductible

The amount you pay before your benefits kick in.

Formulary

A list of drugs covered by your plan that includes generic and brand-name drugs. Our Pharmacy department and doctors decide what drugs to include based on quality, safety and how well they work.

Generic Drug

Drugs with the same active ingredients as the brand-name versions that are reviewed and

approved by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA). They cost less because their makers don't have to spend money on research, development and marketing.

HMO (Health Maintenance Organization)

A plan with personal care from a set network. We recommend choosing a primary care provider to support your health and make sure you get the care you need. You must go to certain doctors and hospitals, unless it's an emergency or for urgent care.

Network

The group of doctors, hospitals, pharmacies and other healthcare providers who've agreed to provide services to our members.

Out-of-Pocket Maximum

Once members have paid this amount, we pay 100% of covered expenses for the rest of the benefit period. You'll no longer pay copays or coinsurance, just your monthly premium.

Premium

The monthly amount you pay for coverage.

Primary Care Provider (PCP)

A personal doctor you choose to support your health and make sure you get the care you need.

Prior Authorization

A review process your doctor asks for to see if your plan will cover certain drugs or services before you get them.
