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#### **Star Measure Description**

This measure shows the percent of female plan members aged 52-74 who had a mammogram during the past two years.

#### **Measure Source**

- Claims
- 1/1-12/31

#### **Requirement Specifications**

The percentage of women MA enrollees 50 to 74 years of age who had a mammogram to screen for breast cancer.

#### **Best Practice/ Call to Action**

- Ensure tests and exclusionary data are documented for patient
- Recommend needed test and prevention

#### **Supplemental Data**

CPT Codes:

- **G9708:** Patient had bilateral mastectomy or unilateral mastectomy
- **G9709:** Patient in hospice (not recommended)

CPT II Codes:

- **3014F:** Screening documented and reviewed
- **3014F-8P:** Screening not recommended for other reasons
