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<b>Star Measure Description</b>
This measure shows the percent of plan members with diabetes who had an A1C lab test during the year that showed their average blood sugar is under control.

<b>Requirement Specifications</b>
The percentage of diabetic MA enrollees 18-75 whose most recent HbA1c level is greater than 9%, or who were not tested during the measurement year.

<b>Best Practice/ Call to Action</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Adjust patients medications based on A1C levels</li> <li>• Order routine lab work             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ HgA1c test bi-annually for patients meeting treatment goals (A1C &lt; 8)</li> <li>✓ HgA1c test quarterly for patients NOT meeting treatment goals</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Refer patients to case management to improve A1C levels</li> </ul>

<b>Exclusions</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Patients actively in hospice</li> <li>• Patients diagnosed with gestational or steroid-induced diabetes</li> </ul>
