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Star Measure Description

This measure shows the percent of plan members aged 50-75 who had appropriate screening for colon cancer.

- Claims & Chart Review
- 1/1-12/31

Requirement Specifications

Eligible Patient has had:

- Hemocult II SENZA: yearly
- Fecal Immunochemical Test (FIT): yearly
- Flexible Sigmoidoscopy: During measurement year or four years prior
- Colonoscopy: During measurement year or nine years prior
- FIT-DNA: During measurement year or two years prior

Best Practice/ Call to Action

- Encourage patients to have colon cancer screening
- Use culturally sensitive counseling and behavioral interviewing
- Discuss with patient the family history of colon cancer

Supplemental Data

CPT Codes:

- **G9710:** Patient in hospice (not recommended)
- **G9711:** Patients diagnosis (not recommended, due to colectomy, or history of cancer)
- **G9901:** Patients 65 and older in a long-term care facility (not recommended)
