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<b>Star Measure Description</b>
This measure shows the percent of plan members with an outpatient visit who had their Body Mass Index (BMI) calculated from their height and weight and recorded in their medical record.

<b>Requirement Specifications</b>
The percentage of MA enrollees 18-74 years of age who had an outpatient visit and whose body mass index (BMI) was documented during the measurement year or the year prior the measurement year.

<b>Best Practice/ Call to Action</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Measure the height once a year to allow BMI calculation</li> </ul>
