<b>Requirement Specifications</b>
Eligible Patient has had: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Hemoccult II SENZA: yearly</li> <li>Fecal Immunochemical Test (FIT): yearly</li> <li>Flexible Sigmoidoscopy: During measurement year or four years prior</li> <li>Colonoscopy: During measurement year or nine years prior</li> <li>FIT-DNA: During measurement year or two years prior</li> </ul>

<b>Best Practice/ Call to Action</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Encourage patients to have colon cancer screening</li> <li>Use culturally sensitive counseling and behavioral interviewing</li> <li>Discuss with patient the family history of colon cancer</li> </ul>
