



Save Money with R_xtra

If you're a Health Alliance member with prescription coverage*, you can save money based on where you have some 30-day supplies of meds filled.

Here's how the pharmacy savings levels work.

- Primary—When you visit Primary pharmacies, you pay the standard copayment for your plan.
- Preferred—When you use Preferred pharmacies, you pay nothing out-of-pocket on hundreds of the most common prescriptions.
- Preferred Plus—In addition to \$0 copayments for the drugs at Preferred pharmacies, you also pay nothing for certain cholesterol and asthma meds at Preferred Plus pharmacies.

Around every corner you'll find a Preferred Plus pharmacy, like:

- Kroger
- Walmart
- Sam's Club
- Osco
- Schnucks
